HEADTEACHER'S WELCOME NEWSLETTER

Welcome back to a new academic year at Heygarth Primary School! It has been wonderful to welcome all of our children back to school this week - they have all settled back into school life so well and are eager to learn. We certainly have lots of wonderful new learning experiences and opportunities planned for them this term.

Also, a special welcome to all of our new families and children who we welcome into F1 (Nursery) and F2 (Reception) as well as across the school - we hope you and your children settle well into our Heygarth family.

School Start & Finish Times

In line with expectations set out in The Schools White Paper that schools will offer a minimum school week of 32.5 hours by September 2023, we have slightly adjusted our school hours from September 2022 to ensure that all children are in school for 32.5 hours each week (excluding Nursery).

F1 (Nursery): 8:45 - 11:45am and 12:30 - 3:30pm

F2 (Reception): 8:50 - 3:20pm

Year 1: 8:55 - 3:25pm

Gate C will open at 8:40am and close at 8:55am.

Year 2: 8:50 - 3:20pm Year 3: 8:55 - 3:25pm

Year 4: 9:00 - 3:30pm

Gate B will open 8:45am and close at 9:00am.

Year 5: 9:00 - 3:30pm Year 6: 9:00 - 3:30pm

Gate A will open at 8:50am and close at 9:00am.

Please stick to your child's start and finish times - they should not be arriving at school too early in the morning and MUST be collected on time after the school day finishes.

There will be 'teething problems' initially at pick up times, but if we can please request you arrive at your allocated time then there will be as few parents as possible at our gates.

Appointments with teachers

Teachers are very busy in the morning preparing for the day ahead and welcoming children into school so after school is always better time to speak to your child's class teacher if you need to. Mr Lewis, Miss Blake and I are at the gates each morning if you need to chat or want to pass on a message. You can also email the school office, who will pass it on.

PE Kits

You should have already received the timetable of when your child has PE and your child should come to school in their PE Kits on these days. It is absolutely fine for your child to wear their usual school jumper or cardigan if they do not yet have a PE hoodie or you do not wish to purchase one. However, children should not be wearing other sports kits with other logos on.

Year 6 Information

The 11+ Examination for Grammar School takes place on Monday 19th September this year for those children in Year 6 who have already applied to take the exam. Further details about your child's assessment date and assessment centre will be sent to you directly.

Free School Meals/Universal Free School Meals

Even though <u>all</u> children in Foundation Stage and Key Stage 1 are entitled to a free meal at lunchtime each day, we still need any parents who claim benefits to register for Free School Meals as this ensures that school continues to receive enhanced funding for their children and also ensures that they receive their free milk entitlement. Key Stage 2 children also need to be registered for Free School Meals if they qualify for the same reason, i.e. milk and school funding.

SIMS InTouch

We are continuing to strive to improve communication with parents and carers and have received lots of positive comments about our electronic communication system that ensures that parents and carers receive letters and school information on a regular basis direct to their mobile phone or computer inbox.

Dinner Monies

Just a reminder that monies for school meals MUST now be paid online using our online payment system ParentPay as we are no longer accepting any cash into the school office. Please ensure that your account is topped up regularly.

Parking

We are only three days into the new term and we've unfortunately already had complaints from neighbours regarding parents parking blocking driveways and even blocking the road so the buses can't get past!

With our staggered start and finish times please, please, please give yourself a little extra time for travelling to school to drop off or pick up your child so you can park a little further away from school and walk.

Please be respectful of our neighbours by not blocking their driveways or parking on their grass verges.

Attendance

This year we will continue to follow guidelines issued by the ESW for attendance. Penalty Notices may be considered appropriate in the following circumstances:

- Attendance below 90% with at least 10 days lost due to unauthorised absence. These do not need to be consecutive.
- 5 days or more unauthorised absence due to holidays in term time, taking into consideration your child's attendance.
- A pupil arrives late after the registers are closed (using a code U) on 10 or more separate occasions.
- In line with other local primary schools and South Wirral High School, we will not authorise any holidays this term.
