Trips/enrichment: Walk around Eastham Village exploring locality and features

Communication and Language

- Listen carefully to stories and poems
- Ask and answer simple questions
- Talk to another person on a topic
- Speak in full, clear sentences

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Follow simple instructions given verbally and/or as pictures
- Explore and engage in their new learning environment
- Describe different feelings in discussion and in the moment
- Understand and follow the rules of the classroom
- Interact with new adults in the classroom to build relationships

Physical Development

- Negotiate the new environment safely
- Identify the space needed for their play
- Move in controlled, energetic ways
- Use classroom tools with control

Literacy

- Retell stories using their own words
- Extend vocabulary by learning new words and applying them in play
- Write recognisable letters, forming them correctly

Mathematics

- Deeply understand numbers to 10 and how ideas can be recorded in different ways
- Compare quantities to 10
- Explore number patterns to 10

Understanding the World

- Understand past and present using personal experiences and through other contexts such as stories
- Observe and understand the current environment
- Understand some processes in the natural world including seasons

Expressive Arts and Design

- Use a wide range of materials and tools, sharing creations and explaining their work to others
- Invent own narratives or adapt known narratives with an adult as needed
- Sing stories, chant rhymes and identify likes and dislikes
