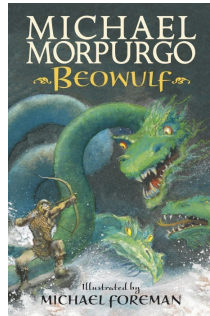

Comparing to instruments now and recognising similarities and differences.

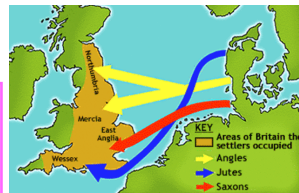
### Science

### History

Use dates to order and place events on a timeline.  
Give reasons for important historical events.  
Make comparisons between periods of history.  
Note connections, contrasts and trend over time.  
Draw conclusions about Anglo-Saxon invasions, settlements and kingdoms: place names and village life.  
Devise historically valid questions.  
Construct informed responses involving thoughtful selection and organisation of relevant historical information.
